THE GIFTS OF CHRISTMAS

It drove me crazy when our parents made us slow down, read the cards and open presents one at a time taking turns. Why did they do that? So that we would appreciate not just the gift, but the giver.

Gift giving at Christmas may have been fueled by ruthlessly greedy retailers here in America, but gift giving at Christmas originated with the birth of Jesus. And if we slow down a bit we may gain a new appreciation for the gifts of Christmas.

Think about it... everyone involved in the Christmas story gave something:

Mary gave her body and reputation. She willingly surrendered her body to bear the Son of God. Furthermore, because she wasn't yet married, she gave her reputation.

Caesar Augustus gave a decree. The Roman emperor called for a census to accomplish his plan of taxing all the people. Although

Caesar thought it was

his idea, God was simply using him to accomplish His divine purpose.

The innkeeper gave a stable. When Mary and Joseph arrived in Bethlehem, the city was so crowded that there was no place for her to give birth. Although the inn was full, the innkeeper gave what he had—a stable for Jesus' birthplace.

The angel of the Lord gave an announcement. The first report of Christ's birth was delivered by a glorious angel to a group of simple shepherds.

The shepherds gave a testimony. After seeing the Messiah, they couldn't keep the news to themselves, but told everyone what they had heard and seen.

The wise men gave gifts and worship. They were probably astrologers or philosophers who came from Persia. When this star caught their attention, they went on a long journey to find the newborn King of the Jews. When they found Jesus, they worshipped Him and offered gifts of gold, frankincense, and myrrh.

God gave His only begotten Son. The greatest gift of all came from God the Father who gave His Son to the world to die as a sacrifice for our sins. What an awesome gift God gave us in His Son, Jesus!

In fact, when you think about it, Christ's entire life

was characterized by giving. From the age of 12 when he sat with the Pharisees and Sadducees in the temple Jesus gave Himself to teaching the truth. He was able to do that because He gave His time to study the Word of God from the time He was a young boy.

As Christ matured, He gave Himself to healing the sick, giving sight to the blind, helping the lame to walk, and casting out demons. He gave Himself to training the twelve disciples and teaching the masses. And Jesus was always giving Himself away in friendship.

It's no wonder Paul gushed forth in 2 Corinthians 9:15, "Thanks be to God for his inexpressible gift!"

What's interesting is that when we truly receive the gift of Jesus into our hearts it utterly transforms us. Our whole way of thinking becomes more and more like Christ. Instead of takers we become givers... not just at Christmastime, but all year long!

For some of us it happens overnight like Ebeneezer Scrooge who instantly became a joyfully generous man. For others it takes a while longer. Whatever the case, when Christ resides in your heart it becomes impossible to remain stingy and small. Generosity is the natural outflow of our inner transformation.

First, we will become very generous in sharing the good

news of the Gospel. Of all the gifts we've ever received, the gift of eternal life is by far the most valuable. That's why we look for opportunities to tell others about what Jesus has done in our lives. Because He can do for them what He's already done for us. What a gift!

Secondly, our natural response to God's blessings and provisions is to have a glad and generous heart. Just as we've received so much from God that we want to share it with others. Generosity actually stokes the fire of joy in our hearts... it feeds on itself. As 2 Corinthians 9:6 says, "whoever sows bountifully will also reap bountifully."

So, beloved, allow me to ask, where is your heart when it comes to giving gifts at Christmas? The generous gift of Jesus has dramatically changed our lives. How will our generous gifts do the same?

During this Advent and Christmas season there are songs of old and new that we sing joyfully. One of my favorite ancient Christmas Hymns is "O Come, O Come, Emmanuel."

The origins of this plaintive carol date to medieval times. In the 800's a series of Latin hymns were sung each day during Christmas Vespers from December 17 to 23. Each of these hymns began with the word "O" and were called the "Great" or "O" Antiphons. These hymns apparently were restructured into verse form from the 1100's and finally published in Latin in 1710. In the mid 1800's, they were discovered by an English minister named John Mason Neale, who wove together segments of them to produce the hymn we sing today. (excerpt from *Come Let Us Adore Him*, by Robert J. Morgan, 2005)

This prayerful hymn is sung in worship of Emmanuel (God With Us), calling us to worship Him.

O come O come Emmanuel

O come Thou Wisdom from on high O come thou rod of Jesse

> O come thou Day-spring come and cheer O come Thou Key of David

> > O come Thou Root of Jesse's tree
> > O come Desire of nations

This Advent season we will be singing different verses of this ancient hymn every week as part of the Call to Worship and the advent candle lighting. In addition to this ancient hymn about Emmanuel, we will be singing a newer song about Emmanuel written by three contemporary writers connected with Getty Music. This song "Sing We the Song of Emmanuel" calls us to sing the song of Emmanuel, come to welcome Emmanuel, and to go and spread the news of Emmanuel. 
21 NEW MEMBERS!







Amazing totals toward helping families to understand that they are loved, and there are choices for them for a sweeter life ahead.






