When people are new to Grace Community I usually see you greeting them and inviting them to be a part of what God is doing in our church. When people are sick, injured or hurting I often see you being the first to offer a hug, a hand, or a word of encouragement. When we put the word out that volunteers are

Speaking as your Pastor, I absolutely love serving the Lord at Grace Community because you are so generous in spirit and in deed. Allow me to take this line of thinking one step deeper... I believe that you are the way you are because Christ has so transformed your hearts with His love that you can't help but to overflow with the things that are of Him. Scriptures would say that He's given you a heart of flesh instead of a heart of stone.

And what kind of fruit does the Spirit produce in a heart of flesh? Love, joy, peace, patience, kindness,

goodness, faithfulness, gentleness, and self-control (Galatians 5:22). Can you think of anything better?

Sometimes, however, if you're really honest with

yourself, you'll notice there are times and seasons where you're just not feeling love, joy or generosity in your heart. Maybe you haven't been seeking the Lord in prayer or in study of His word. Maybe your heart doesn't seem so big, bright, or beautiful.

Why is that? It's because, as the old hymn goes, "our hearts are prone to wander." Living in

a fallen, sinful world, we sometimes forget our first love... Jesus Christ. When that happens, we tend to revert to our *"old self"* instead of the new creation which we now are in Christ. Rather than tender hearts, we foster stony hearts.

Only when our motives and purposes are fully centered on pleasing God do we find them beginning to look big, bright and beautiful again. St. Augustine called this the *"re-ordering of our loves."* When our greatest love in life is Jesus Christ people begin to notice. Why? Because His presence in our lives spills over into our relationships... in other words, people see the fruit of the Holy Spirit in your life.

We're told in Genesis 6:5 that every human heart has an inclination which reflects our deepest commitments. It

is what we treasure the most. It determines our direction and attitude in life. No wonder Jesus is so concerned about our hearts.

So, when we find ourselves feeling stony of heart and wandering far from Christ how do we ever find our way back to our first love? You can't do it merely by changing your thinking, or through great acts of will, but rather by changing what you love most.

Change happens not only by giving your mind new truths — though it does involve that — but also by feeding the imagination new beauties so you love Jesus supremely. We change when we change what we worship the most.

Lent is a season designed for Christians to help us re-order our loves. It's a forty-day period beginning with Ash Wednesday and ending with Holy Week. It's meant to help us understand the suffering and beauty of our crucified Savior whose heart was crushed and broken on the Cross for us (Psalm 22:14).

I want to invite you to join me in our Lenten journey beginning February 22nd with Ash Wednesday worship at 11:00 a.m. As we seek the Lord with new eyes may your heart be ever more tender to His heart and may He shine ever more brightly through you!







If you are already pictured in the directory and are happy with the photo, you do not need to have a new photo taken.




The Sharing and Caring support group will continue meeting on the 1st & 3rd Thursdays of the month at 10:30 a.m.
