LOVE & ASHES

Seventh grade was a distinctly awkward year for me. Maybe you can relate.

My body was catching up with my teeth. I had growing pain in the joints. I stuttered a bit. The haircuts my father gave me were not cool at all. And the Sears Tough Skin jeans with iron on patches that I wore didn't look all that groovy.

All this did not help me the day I looked up in social studies class and realized that God had made these amazing creatures called girls. Sitting right across from me was Bonnie Brown. I don't know exactly why or how I realized that she existed, but I was suddenly awakened.

Every day I looked forward to social studies because I could gaze at her for an entire forty-five minutes from across the aisle. I was smitten. I was sure it was love.

If I could only talk to her... maybe carry her books to class. I tried everything I could imagine to get Bonnie's attention. I even wrote her initials with mine in fresh cement outside of the school. Surely, she would notice the big heart I drew around the inscription.

Alas, all of my efforts seemed futile. It was as if Bonnie didn't even know I existed.

Then one Wednesday morning I saw my big opportunity. We both arrived at class before anyone else. Immediately, I noticed that she had something on her forehead. So, I said to her, "Hey Bonnie, did you know that you have a smudge on your forehead?"

As awkward a moment as it was for me, Bonnie was kind with her response. "It's Ash Wednesday silly. Where are your ashes?"

I looked at her thunderstruck. What was she talking about? "What's Ash Wednesday?" I asked.

The only thing Bonnie ever really said to me I'll never forget...

"Ash Wednesday begins the forty days of Lent when I'm reminded to love Jesus more than anything in the world."

I'm not sure how I responded

to Bonnie, but I've always thought that was a pretty amazing definition for Ash Wednesday. In the Bible, ashes tend to represent repentance, self-abhorrence, and mourning. When someone hears terrible news, such as Job, when he discovers his family and possessions have been destroyed, they tend to anoint their heads

have been destroyed, they tend to anoint their heads with dust or ashes.

Abraham said of himself in Genesis 18, "I am but dust and ashes." Since humans come from dust, placing dust on our heads reminds us of our humanity, mortality, and the finite state of our nature.

Ash Wednesday reminds us that we are profoundly in need of a Savior who can give us the hope of eternal life.

It's appropriate that this year Ash Wednesday falls on the same day as Valentine's Day. On the one hand, it awakens us to the immensity of God's love for us in sending His one and only Son Jesus Christ to take our place on the cross for us. He literally bled and died that we might live. What a Savior!




Our Church Photo Directory is a wonderful resource for getting to know people in our church family. It is especially helpful for new attendees to help them put names with faces.







WHY READ THE BIBLE?

Today, many people keep the Bible a closed book. One reason is because we don't realize how much we need it. If I suggested that you stop eating for a few months, you'd ignore me-and rightly so. We need food in order to survive, and without food we'll grow weak and eventually die.

Yet many Christians are spiritually starved and weak because they ignore the spiritual "food" God has provided in the Bible. The Bible is not an option; it is a necessity. You cannot grow spiritually strong without it.

Job said, "I have treasured the words of his mouth more than my daily bread" (Job 23:12). Is the Bible this important to you?

Don't look on the Bible as a badtasting medicine—think of it instead as a delightful food that God has given us to strengthen our souls! The Psalmist said, "Blessed is the one ... whose delight is in the law of the Lord" (Psalm 1:1-2).

You see, God wants you to grow in your faith—and one of the ways that happens is through reading God's Word and letting its truth sink deeply into our hearts and minds. Through the Bible we learn how God wants us to live, and we learn too what He has done to save us.

Most of all we discover who He is and what He wants to do in our lives. The Apostle Paul put it this way: "All Scripture is God-breathed and is useful for teaching, rebuking, correcting and training in righteousness, so that the servant of God may be thoroughly equipped for every good work" (2 Timothy 3:16-17).






