THE JOY OF SCRIPTURE MEMORIZATION

I received an email from a snowbird friend of mine who went north about a month ago. It reads like this,

"Pastor Cliff I was a little concerned when you first advised me on how I might be a good witness to my grandkids this summer. You recommended that I make time for creating great memories with them. So, we're renting a cabin on a lake for a week. No problem.

Then you suggested memorizing Scripture. Ugh! I've never memorized Scripture before in my entire life! But I took the ten verses which you recommended and I learned them inside and out. You said, 'God will give you the openings to use these effectively at just the right time.'

Wow, were you ever right! I've had three great conversations with one of my grandsons and one excellent conversation with my granddaughter. I never thought they would care to listen, but they did! And the summer is only just beginning..."

My friend added a P.S. "There is something wonderful happening inside my heart because of these Scriptures. I'm already memorizing more!"

Those words are music to your Pastor's ears!

Chuck Swindoll once wrote, "I know of no other single practice in the Christian life more rewarding, practically speaking, than memorizing Scripture... No other single exercise pays greater spiritual dividends! Your prayer life will be strengthened. Your witnessing will be sharper and much more effective. Your attitudes and outlook will begin to change. Your mind will become alert and observant. Your confidence and assurance will be enhanced. Your faith will be solidified."

I couldn't agree more with Chuck Swindoll's words!

Friends, I want to challenge you this summer to begin memorizing the word of God. Consider the following tips that may assist you with memorizing: 1) Choose one passage a day read it & repeat it ten times a day, 2) Memorize with friends who can test you, and 3) Pray that God would help you to treasure His Word in your heart.

VERSES TO MEMORIZE

1. 2 CORINTHIANS 5:21

For our sake he made him to be sin who knew no sin, so that in him we might become the righteousness of God.

2. ISAIAH 53:5

But he was pierced for our transgressions; he was crushed for our iniquities; upon him was the chastisement that brought us peace, and with his wounds we are healed.

3. 1 JOHN 1:9

If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.

4. ACTS 4:12

And there is salvation in no one else, for there is no other name under heaven given among men by which we must be saved.

5. 1 THESSALONIANS 5:16-18

Rejoice always, pray without ceasing, give thanks in all circumstances; for this is the will of God in Christ Jesus for you.

6. PSALM 73:25-26

Whom have I in heaven but you? And there is nothing on earth that I desire besides you. My flesh and my heart may fail, but God is the strength of my heart and my portion forever.

7. MARK 8:35-36

For whoever would save his life will lose it, but whoever loses his life for my sake and the gospel's will save it. For what does it profit a man to gain the whole world and forfeit his soul?

As you can see, Actual Unrestricted Contributions are much higher than the budget. This is good news!

We wish to thank you for your kind generosity.

As you can see, we have spent very close to the budget for actual Operating Expenditures. Again this is good news! You might be thinking "Oh, this is great, we are ahead!" However, that is not entirely true.

We have also spent almost \$16,500 on Capital Improvements. These items are not included in our Operating Expenses. So, our Total Expenditures actually exceed our Operations Budget.

If you work in the **MUSIC FIELD** - you are qualified


If you can hear **WITHOUT THE AID OF A HEARING DEVICE** - you are qualified




