

ENTHRONING THE GOD WE LOVE

"Bless the Lord, O my soul, and all that is within me, bless his holy name."

- PSALM 103:1

I remember hearing those words of the psalmist over and over again in my college fellowship group. I didn't get it. How could I bless the Lord of Creation? He made it all. Isn't He the one who picks up the check so to speak? He's the Host, the Master, the Provider and the blesser. It seems kinda silly that we would bless Him.

But the psalmist is emphatic that we are to bless the Lord from our very soul with all that is within us. Besides,

it's Lent and doesn't that mean we should be walking around in proverbial sackcloth and ashes with a spirit of repentance? Is it not the season for blessing the Lord.

The truth is, it's always the season for blessing the Lord. Look at the words that follow in Psalm 103: *"And forget not all his*

benefits, who forgives all your iniquity, who heals all your diseases, who redeems your life from the pit, who crowns you with steadfast love and mercy, who satisfies you with good so that your youth is renewed like the eagle's."

Meditate on those verses for a moment. This describes just a few of the benefits the Lord bestows on His children. Lent is indeed a season where we very intentionally focus on the theme of repentance (and yes, we should always be repentant). The point is, genuine remorse for our sins should direct us to the only One who is able to deal with our sinful selves... the One who as the Psalmist would, forgives us, heals us, redeems us, crowns us with love and mercy, satisfies us and renews us.

Okay, but that still doesn't answer the question of *how* we can bless the Lord.

Actually, humbly recognizing our sinfulness and our



total dependence on the grace of God is the first step toward genuinely blessing the Lord. There is no way in the world that God is honored by anything less.

Allow me to pause and ask a quirky question, if you were the King of the Universe, on what kind of a throne would you sit? Obviously, you could

make it out of anything... diamonds, starlight, angel hair... But what does the God who has everything truly prize as so valuable that he would make His throne out of it?

David prays in Psalm 22:3 "Yet, you are holy, enthroned on the praises of Israel." Another translation says that He "inhabits" the praises of His people. In other words, He takes up residence as Ruler in a throne room echoing with our worship. Out of all that exists in the universe God chose to build



His throne out of the blessings of His people. He sits upon our praises as He rules the universe.



The Mission Committee is looking into participating in a hands-on ministry that connects

prisoners with mentors in a Christ-Centered relationships.

The heart of Crossroads is connecting people inside prison with mentors on the outside. We connect people in prison, who are often lonely and in need of encouragement, with caring volunteer mentors who write them letters packed with hope and love. We are committed to creating life-changing Bible study material for people in prison. As mentors review their students' lessons, they find that their lives change too.

After completing the first level of Crossroads Bible study courses, students are connected oneon-one with a mentor who guides them through their studies. As the student and mentor exchange letters, they develop a close relationship that transforms both of them.

This mentorship program is utilized by ministry leaders in more that twenty countries. They provide these leaders with resources, training and support as they bring the Gospel to prison cells around the world.

"I needed clothes and you clothed me, I was sick and you looked after me, I was in prison and you came to visit me....Truly I tell you, whatever you did to the least of these bothers and sisters of mine, you did for me." Mathew 25:36, 40





SINGING THE LEVITICUS BLUES

Some of us have been singing the "Leviticus Blues" lately. As we read through the Bible this year, it's easy to get bogged down in when you start reading the third book of the Bible known as Leviticus.



Leviticus can be some very heavy reading, BUT DON'T GIVE UP! This book is very important to our understanding of the Old Testament sacrificial system. And understanding the sacrificial system is absolutely necessary to our understanding of Christ's sacrifice on the cross.

Leviticus is one of the most referenced books in the New Testament and by the time you reach the Book of Hebrews you'll be looking back to Leviticus frequently.

Leviticus isn't always easy to understand. We don't always know the exact details of why and how some sacrifices were made. Even so, the more we understand Leviticus the more we'll begin to understand the gravity of Christ's sacrifice for us.

Keep in mind that the pivotal verse in Leviticus is 19:2 which says, "You shall be holy, for I the Lord your God am holy." That verse opens up a

whole other set of questions, but simply put, we can only be holy through faith in a holy and righteous God revealed to us in the person of Jesus Christ.

So, while Leviticus may at times be laborious, be encouraged, your efforts in reading this book and other challenging books of the Old Testament will be ultimately beneficial to your understanding of Jesus Christ and the Bible. Remember, that the entirety of the Bible... every word, every verse, is designed to point to Jesus. So read on dear friends!

DEACON CARE GROUPS

You may or may not know it, but you have most likely been assigned a Deacon. Each of our Deacons have a portion of people who are members or regular attenders of Grace Community.

The purpose of the Care Groups is three-fold: **1**) to help you when you have specific needs... spiritually, physically, emotionally; **2**) to help the pastor with an awareness of the needs of a growing congregation, and; **3**) to help others to know how to best pray for and encourage you.
